

The Knowledge Center Flemish Cities (Kenniscentrum Vlaamse Steden) is an interlocal association of the 13 major Flemish cities and the Commission for the Flemish Community in Brussels.

We support our partners in multi-annual programs with themes (important challenges for city in Flanders) selected by the management teams of our partners (i.e. the cities). For the multi-annual program 2017-2021 the cities chose Smart Cities as an important challenge and this track is continued in the program 2022-2026.

Another important part of our multi-annual Smart City Program is the yearly excursion to an influential Smart City or Smart Region in Europe. In the recent past we organised excursions to Barcelona (2017 and 2018) and Eindhoven (2019) and last year we organised a digital visit to the city of Porto. For our next excursion the steering committee of the Smart City program nominated the city of Bordeaux.
